With North Carolina in Phase 2, we are pleased to say that we are resuming our weekly tennis clinics in Cary for all TFL members.

Wednesdays, 7:00pm – 8:00pm (Summer Session)

Incorporating input from Western Wake Tennis Association (WWTa), Raleigh Tennis Associate (RTA), and our tennis professional Coach Kirstie Marx, we have come up with a way to offer the tennis clinics keeping in mind the health and safety of the players and coach. As with all our TFL activities, it is up to each individual to choose to participate.

Tennis Clinic Guidelines:

- Play at your own risk/comfort level.
- Do not attend if you are not well, have any Coronavirus related symptoms, or been exposed to someone who has the Coronavirus.
- Maximum of 6 players for each clinic. Each player must pre-register.
- Only TFL members may play. Guests are not allowed.
- Wearing face masks are optional and up to each person.
- Bring your own water.
- Bring your own tennis racket. If you do not have one, contact Victoria.
- Tennis balls
 - All tennis balls will be provided by the Coach.
 - The Coach will feed all tennis balls to the players.
 - The players may optionally help pick up the balls on the court. The Coach will provide hand sanitizer to use after picking up the balls.
- Social distance while on/off the court. Do not congregate during breaks.

The Guidelines are subject to change because of state/local government regulations and input from our TFL partners.

Tennis Clinic Registration

[SignUpGenius](#) will be used to register for a tennis clinic. A maximum of 6 people may register for each session subject to the following:

- TFL members will receive e-mail with the registration link(s).

- Signups may be done up to 2 weeks in advance.
- To provide opportunity for more people to participate in the clinics, someone who already played the week before, must wait until the Monday before the next clinic to sign up. For example, if Victoria plays on June 10th and wants to play again the following week, then Victoria needs to wait until Monday, June 15th, to sign up for June 17th if there's space.
- If you sign up and no longer able to play, please cancel your sign up in SignUpGenius.
- Victoria will monitor the sign ups to ensure the guidelines are followed.
- If you have any problems using SignUpGenius or have questions, please contact Victoria.
- Clinics that are canceled due to weather or other reasons will not be made up.
